OPEN BURNING PERMIT

Any person desiring to conduct open burning of material not permitted as stated in SECTION 11: Section 3-2-19 of the City Code may make an application to the City of North Chicago for a special permit no less than seven (7) days prior to the event to allow a supervised open burning event.

The special permit shall specify the date, time, place and purpose of the event; the person, firm or entity responsible for supervision of the event; and reasonable measures to be taken to protect public health, safety and welfare. No such permit shall be granted without the prior approval of the fire chief or his or her designee.
