

YOU MUST BE CURRENTLY WORKING AS A FULL-TIME DEPUTY SHERIFF OR MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.

1. Available to work all shifts, including holidays and weekends.
2. Currently employed as a Deputy Sheriff or Municipal Police Officer; and,
3. Good standing in their department as of the date of certification by the Merit Commission; and,
4. Three years of full-time, continuous experience with the same law enforcement agency where currently employed, the definition of which includes, but is not limited to, authority to make arrest and carry firearms; and,
5. Successfully completed Illinois Basic Police Officer Training, or successfully completed Basic Police Officer Training Program which can be transferred and accepted by the Illinois State Training Board; and,
6. Complete a Supplemental Transfer Application in addition to the Board of Fire and Police Commission's regular application; and,
7. Must pass the Screening/Background Investigation.
